<b>Objectives:</b>  Show the ability to retrace information and compare artists' work. Ability to use key vocabulary when evaluating artists'.	
<b>Learning activities (in order to be completed):</b>  Print off the cubism worksheet and complete it to a high standard. Your writing must include correct punctuation, spellings and vocabulary, showing your understanding of Cubism so far.  Complete the tonal colouring section and then add colour to your font (the title) keeping in the theme of the colours used by the artists'. Your tonal section must show smooth application with a pencil, and must demonstrate a minimum of 3 shades with a pencil.  Keep your worksheet and bring it in to school when you return.
