Subject: History Yr 7	Week: (19/10/2020)
Objective: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To understand why William won the Battle of Hastings• To link your causes together• To evaluate which causes were the most important	
Learning activities (in order to be completed): <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Using the assessment guide sheet and the causes for why William won sheet you are going to write a structured piece of writing with 6 paragraphs.2) In your introduction you need to include basic information such as the two leaders who were fighting at Hastings, the year that it happened and the end result.3) You then need to do a paragraph for each of the section (use the guide sheet) where you will write about the causes on the causes sheet. E.g. For William's skill you could include that his army tricked Harold's. Make sure you explain thoroughly why these things would help William to win.4) You also need to try and link your causes .e.g. it was easy for William to trick Harold's men as they had been drinking the night before and therefore would not be as focused for fighting. You can also mention that Harold's army was in a poor condition as they had been drinking the night before as well as having already fought at Stamford bridge, so they would be wounded and tired as well.5) For the conclusion explain what you think the most important reason that William won was and why.
