Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for your interest in the Maths visit to London. I am very pleased to share with you that we have managed to secure additional capacity on the visit, meaning that all those who expressed an interest are able to be offered a place. The visit will take place on Wednesday, 5th June.

Final details will be confirmed nearer the time and the following may be subject to change. However, it is our intention to travel by coach to London (leaving school at approximately 06:30). On arrival, we will visit the Bank of England Museum allowing students to explore its role, history and how it influences our finances. Next, we will break for lunch (packed lunches required). We will then be taken on a professional guided walking tour of the Capital. Students will take part in Maths challenges whilst seeing some of London's famous landmarks. Then, we will depart for home, stopping at the services on the way. This will allow those who wish to purchase dinner to do so. The estimated return time is 21:00.

The total cost is dependent on how many students commit to the trip, but we still estimate it to be approximately £65. For students in receipt of Pupil Premium, this is estimated at £21.67. We will be able to confirm the price once the deposit deadline has passed. In addition, we are actively applying for grants and bursaries that may reduce the cost of the trip should our applications be successful. We will, of course, inform you of this should we have any positive news.

If you still wish your child to take part in this trip, please pay a deposit of £25 (£8.34 for Pupil Premium) on ParentPay using the 'London Maths Visit 2024 DEPOSIT' option by 11.00 am on Thursday, 7th December.

We look forward to making this an exciting and memorable day for our students!
