PE DEPARTMENT STANDON BOWERS YEAR 8 VISIT 25 – 29 NOVEMBER 2024

We are in the process of booking a week at Standon Bowers Outdoor Education Centre and are pleased to offer your child a place on the trip.

Activities include rock-climbing, BMX riding, team building, abseiling, archery, map work, caving in Alderley Edge and bridge building, as well as 'night activities'. Children will stay in dormitories and use the facilities of Standon Bowers (showers, drying rooms, dining room, classrooms etc.) and all their specialist clothing and equipment.

The cost of the 4 night, 5-day course for students in receipt of pupil Premium is £81.66 (dependant on numbers), which represents excellent value and covers all accommodation, meals, transport, etc.

If you would like to take the first step to securing a place, please pay a **non-refundable deposit of £20** via ParentPay and give your consent for your child to attend, by **Friday, 2 February 2024.**

No further places will be available after this date, unless a student withdraws due to unforeseen circumstances.

Payment can be made in four instalments or you can pay the full amount via ParentPay:

- **1st payment (£20 non-refundable deposit) by 2nd February 2024**
- **2nd payment (£20) by 1st March 2024**
- **3rd payment (£20) by 1st April 2024**
- **4th payment (£21.66) by 3rd May 2024**

If you have any problems using ParentPay then please contact the school office.

Please note that if your child withdraws from the trip after the 25 September 2024, Standon Bowers will charge you 60% of the total cost which is £48.99.

Please note that the school reserves the right to exclude a child from the visit at any time if it is felt that the student's behaviour in school does not warrant a place on the visit, however it is hoped that this measure will not be required.
