**Date: Week of 1<sup>st</sup> June 2024**

At a Science Department pyramid meeting; where all three Uttoxeter Middle Schools and the High School meet, the Science departments discussed the transition arrangements for 2024 to the High School. It has been agreed that all year 8 transfer tests will be sat during the week of 1<sup>st</sup> June 2024.

The Transfer test covers the Science content that the pupils have studied over Year 7 and Year 8 in the Middle Schools.

The Science departments feel that this will give far more information about the pupils. This will be used at the moderation meeting together with the input from the pupils' teachers to place the pupils in the most appropriate grouping for the High School.

The 50 min Transfer test will be based on the units listed.

- Cells
- Reproduction
- Food and Digestions
- Atoms, Elements and Compounds
- Acids and Alkalis
- Particles
- Light
- Heating and Cooling

However, please understand that we are available if your child has a particular question or problem about a topic area. May we suggest that your child plans a schedule in advance and these sites may be useful as aids to their revision programme,
